

Project update: February 2022

Construction begins spring 2022

The City of Anoka and MnDOT are working together to repair aging roads and bridges on Hwy 10 between Thurston Ave. and 7th Ave. in Anoka. The two-year reconstruction project begins in spring 2022. When complete, the Hwy 10 Anoka project will improve traffic flow, decrease congestion and increase safety. Construction is expected to be completed in spring 2024.

Construction impacts

Between April and November, drivers will encounter:

- Only one driving lane in each direction on Hwy 10
- Ongoing ramp closures to/from Hwy 10 and local roads
- Height restrictions at Thurston Ave. and Fair oak Ave. as new Hwy 10 overpasses are constructed

Be prepared for traffic delays on Hwy 10

- Visit and bookmark the project webpage and sign up to receive email updates on traffic impacts
- Check real-time traffic before traveling: 511mn.org or call 511
- Take alternative highways around the construction area
- Travel outside of rush hour times
- Use Metro Transit buses or Northstar commuter rail
- For the safety of the community, follow posted detour routes and avoid using local roads for detours
