Incorporating people with disabilities into the workforce

Gaining independence, reaching new goals

Sierra Jones-Iverson has been an important part of her FedEx team for four years, growing in her responsibilities as well as increasing the number of hours she works. Her duties have included unloading packages from trucks and relabeling boxes to prepare for shipment.

With nonprofit organization Opportunity Partners' support, Sierra has gained confidence on the job, too. In her quest to gain greater independence in her life, she has picked up additional shifts, nearly doubling her hours from 16 to 30 per week during busy periods.

Sierra didn't let knee surgery slow her down, even when she had to wear a brace and undergo physical rehabilitation. "Everybody was amazed I was still working with my brace," she said, adding that she especially enjoys working with so many nice people.

Sierra, 30, is proud of all she has achieved. She is working toward advancing her career at FedEx, hoping to become a manager or trainer someday. She enjoys earning her own money and making her own decisions.

In all, Opportunity Partners supported 300 people with disabilities including Sierra in community jobs in 2021. The assistance that Opportunity Partners provides includes job coaching, training assistance and ongoing support to help people succeed.

Companies benefit by having a dedicated employee and enhancing diversity and inclusion in the workplace, and individuals with disabilities benefit by gaining work experience that can lead to greater independence in the future.

MN FoodShare is here and we're looking for partners to help address hunger in our community! After the holidays, giving drops nearly in half while the need for food, clothing and resources continues to rise. In 2021 we had over 10,000 visits, assisting more than 32,000 individuals with food and other resources.

MN FoodShare is a statewide food and fund drive established to not only bring awareness to hunger insecurity during this traditionally slow time, but also giving us an opportunity to earn additional money based on the total pounds and dollars we raise! The event goes from February 28th through April 10th and our goals are **100,000lbs of food and \$75,000**. We also have a \$10,000 matching grant from Otto Bremer Trust that can double the impact of new donors.

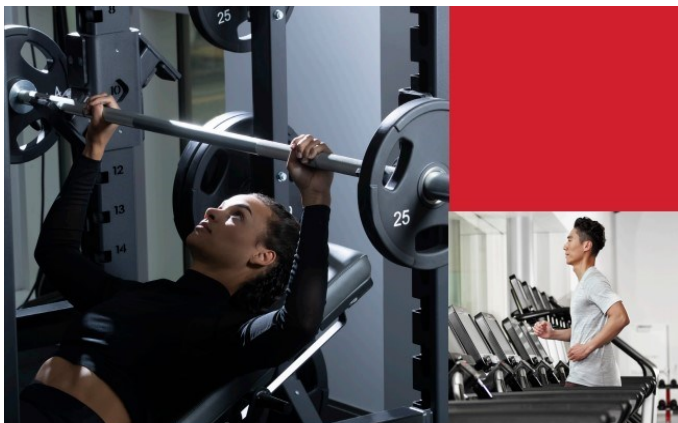

Chamber Board of Directors Nominations Letter to Membership

TO: General Membership of the Anoka Area Chamber of Commerce

RE: Request for nominations for the Board of Directors of the Anoka Area Chamber of Commerce for three-year terms.

Article 6, Section 4 of the By-Laws of the Anoka Area Chamber of Commerce states that 135 days prior to the end of the fiscal year (September 30), all members in good standing shall be contacted requesting nominations for the Board of Directors, and is to be returned to the Chamber office no later than 120 days prior to the end of the fiscal year. At that time, the Board of Directors shall review the nominations and present a slate of five candidates to replace the directors whose regular three-year terms are expiring. The Board of Directors will confirm the fact by personal contact with the candidates, that they are willing to accept directorship responsibilities. Please keep in mind that any director nominated should be capable of serving as an officer of the Chamber, since officers are elected from the Board of Directors.

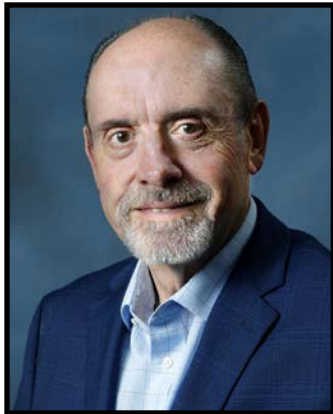

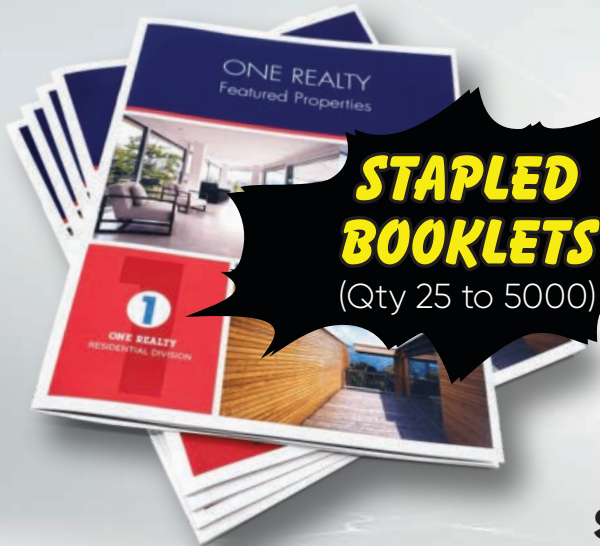

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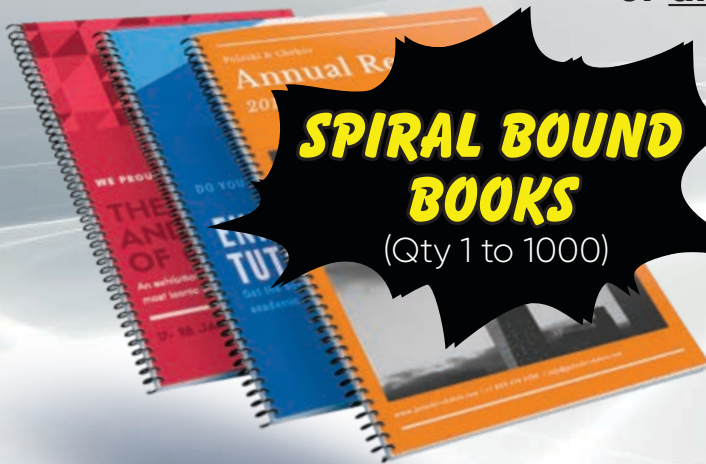


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
